**SPONSORED SEAT SCHEME –
SEAHAM CEMETERY AT BYRON’S WALK**

Seaham Town Council is promoting a sponsored seat scheme in the new cemetery, which has recently opened at Byron’s Walk.

Pre-planned locations have been set aside throughout the cemetery where a particular type of decorative hard wood seats can be installed.

In fitting with the overall design of the cemetery all sponsored seats, need to be of the standard design and construction.

The total cost of the seat is dependant upon the amount of lettering to be carved directly onto the seat, although the basic seat price starts at approximately £1195.00 (teak wood) £960.00 (iroko wood)

The cost of engraving the seat is £3.50 per letter.
